- Students must be checked out by 1:45 p.m. for early checkout



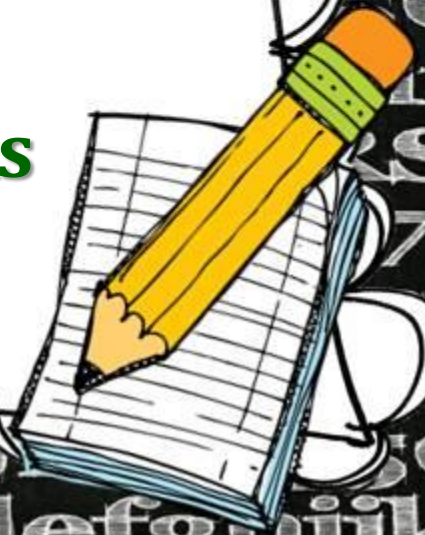

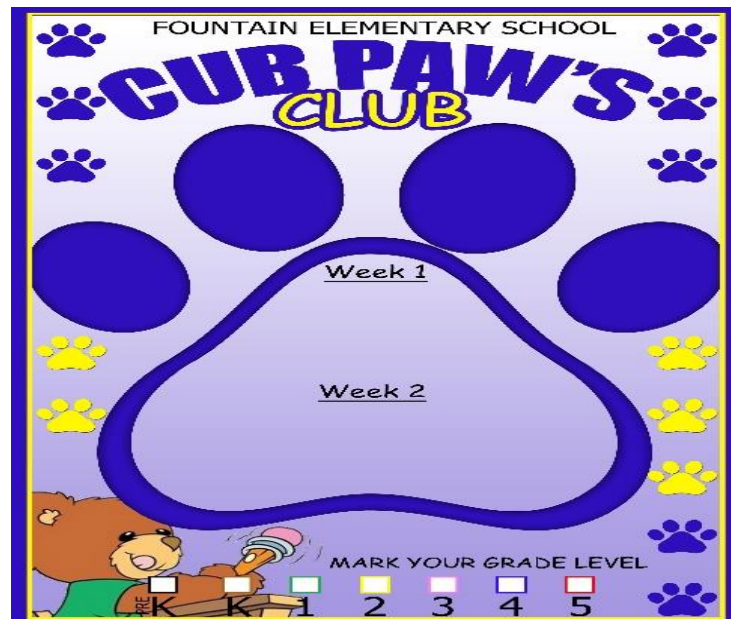
